Ward 2 Election to Fill Unexpired Term of Councilman George Wolverton

The City of Pascagoula will hold a Special Election on **Tuesday March 19, 2019** to elect a City Council representative for Ward 2, filling the unexpired term of Councilman George Wolverton, who passed away earlier this week. The term for this seat expires on June 30, 2021.

Here is more information about the Special Election:

- This election is for registered voters in **WARD 2 ONLY**
- The voting location is: IGLESIA BAUTISTA FUENTE DE VIDA Church located at 3819 Arlington Street in Pascagoula (The former location of Arlington Baptist Church)
- This is a **NO PARTY AFFILIATION** race. (Candidates do not have to declare a party affiliation.)
- **THOSE INTERESTED IN DECLARING AS CANDIDATES MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:**
 - Obtain the signatures of 50 (verified) registered voters in Pascagoula (Request or pick up a copy of the official signature sheet from the City Clerk's office in City Hall.)
 - Signature sheets must be submitted in person to the City Clerk by the deadline (2/25/2019) and voters' signatures will be verified through the State Election Management System (SEMS)
 - **QUALIFYING FOR THIS SPECIAL ELECTION ENDS on MONDAY, FEBRUARY 25th by 5:00 p.m.**

Posting Dates for Special Election Notice:

Tuesday, February 26, 2019 – 21 days before special election

Posting notices in three public places, one of which is City Hall, on Tuesday, February 26, 2019.

Tuesday, February 19, 2019:

The voter registration deadline would be February 19, 2019 for both in person registration and the postmark date for mailed application as February 18, 2019 is a State and Federal Holiday.

Deadline to Qualify to Run for Office:

Monday, February 25, 2019 – 5:00 p.m.

Special Election Date:

Tuesday, March 19, 2019 – 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Runoff Election Date:

Tuesday, April 9, 2019 – 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.
