ABSENTEE VOTING RULES DETAILED

Notice for Those Eligible to Vote in Ward 2 Special Election

Pascagoula, MS – (March 6, 2019) Those residents of Pascagoula who are registered to vote in the upcoming Special Election in Ward 2 but unable to participate in person at the polling location on Tuesday, March 19, 2019 (Iglesia Bautista Fuente de Vida, 3189 Arlington Street) are reminded of the ABSENTEE VOTING RULES as set forth by Mississippi Statute:

- Absentee Voting begins TOMORROW, Thursday, March 7, 2019.
- Those eligible to vote absentee can obtain an Application and Ballot, and complete it, in person at City Hall – Clerk's Office from 8:00 am – 5:00 p.m.
- Absentee voting dates are Thursday and Friday, March 7-8 (8:00am-5:00 pm); Monday – Friday, March 11-15 (8:00 am-5:00 pm); and Saturday, March 16, 8:00 am – Noon AT CITY HALL located at 603 Watts Ave.
- You can request an Absentee Ballot and Application be mailed to you, by calling the Clerk's Office at 228-938-6615 or emailing KKennedy@cityofpascagoula.com
- You may complete and return the Absentee Ballot and Application BY MAIL, but they MUST BE POSTMARKED no later than MONDAY, MARCH 18, 2019. No applications or ballots for absentee voting will be mailed to a requestor after Friday, March, 15, 2019 5:00 p.m.
- State I.D. is required for absentee voting.

We encourage all eligible voters to participate in the Special Election – Ward 2 on Tuesday, March 19 or by voting absentee during the absentee voting period outlined above.
