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**PUBLIC NOTICE**

By Resolution of the City Council of Pascagoula, MS, the City of Pascagoula is now accepting resumes for candidates for the following voluntary Board positions. These will be filled by appointment from the Pascagoula City Council in April, 2019:

1. **The Pascagoula Redevelopment Authority** (1 seat available)– The Pascagoula Redevelopment Authority (PRA) is an urban renewal agency established by the City of Pascagoula pursuant to and acting under the authority of Section 43-35-1 et seq. of the Mississippi Code. It is composed of a 5 member board appointed by the Pascagoula City Council serving staggered five year terms. The board serves to promote and encourage revitalization in the Urban Renewal Area. Anchor Square and the Courtyards at City Dock (Part of the Riverfront Project) are prime examples of the PRA's progress in Pascagoula.
2. **The LaPointe-Krebs Foundation** (1 seat available) – The purpose of the LaPointe-Krebs Foundation, Inc. is to promote, maintain, keep-up, and operate the LaPointe-Krebs House, adjacent grounds and structure in order to preserve the historic property for future generations. Located on the Mississippi Gulf Coast in Pascagoula, the LaPointe-Krebs house, built in 1757, is the oldest structure in Mississippi and is the oldest confirmed building in the entire Mississippi Valley. The house is currently undergoing an Extensive Restoration along with a major fundraising effort.
3. **Jackson County Utility Authority** (1 seat available) – The Mission of the JCUA is to lead Jackson County in a unified, efficient, approach in the protection of public health and the environment by providing consistent, quality water, wastewater, and environmental services to ensure the wise, beneficial use of public resource. Board meetings are held twice a month, at JCUA offices in Pascagoula.
4. **Historic Preservation Commission** (1 seat available) - The City's Historic Preservation Commission is comprised of nine individuals. The commission makes recommendations for surveys, nominates projects for National Registry, and assists building owners with historic tax credits.
