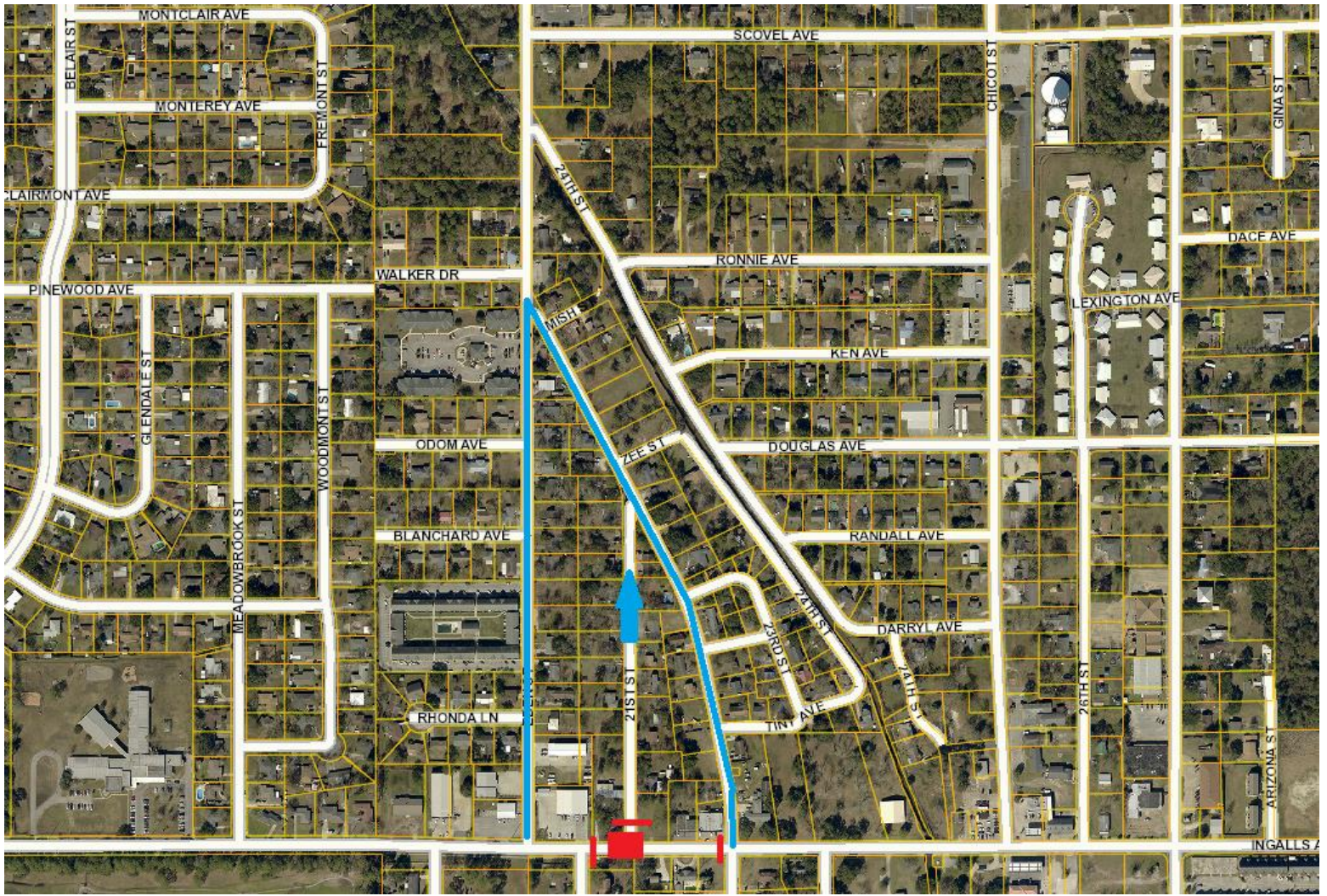
**Sewer Line Work on Ingalls Ave to Begin Monday June 17**  
*Repairs Expected to Take 3 Days*  
*Please Read Closure & Detour Information*

Repairs to address failure(s) of the sewer line, approximately 10' deep are planned to begin Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> in the morning. The City crews will be forced to CLOSE Ingalls Avenue between Woodhaven and 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. *Please see the attached MAP.*

Ingalls Avenue will be closed in BOTH DIRECTIONS on Monday. The detour around the work is 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Eden St. (In blue on the map). Residents in that area can expect an increase in traffic. Streets to the south of the work, 22<sup>nd</sup> St. and Woodhaven, will not have their streets impacted, but may need to access the detour, as well.

The City's plan is if the sewer failure is quickly located and fixed, work should only take 2-3 days to complete. However, if the damage is more extensive than anticipated, those travelling on Ingalls Avenue east of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street should expect to continue to take the detour around the work. If it will take more than 2-3 days, the city will work to re-open at least one lane in each direction if possible.
