



'GOULA CRUISE COMMITTEE ANNOUNCES RV CITY at POINT PARK Cruisers with RVs Have A New Overnight Option In Pascagoula

Pascagoula, MS – (August 15, 2019) “The ‘Goula Cruise Committee is proud to be working with Main Street Pascagoula and the city to bring a new and exciting option to Cruisers with RVs who want to stay overnight here and take advantage of this beautiful scenery,” said ‘Goula Cruise Committee Chair Nicky Maxwell.

“We work year round, and have worked as a committee for about five years now to make our part of *Cruisin’ the Coast* better and better for our city and the classic car enthusiasts who come from all over to be a part of the excitement. I think this year we’ve got a great addition to the three day event by giving registered cruisers an opportunity to STAY overnight in their RV’s at beautiful Point Park all week. We have 45 spots available, and have already received a few calls.

“With Pascagoula as an official stamp site, we see more registered Cruisers each year at the venue in Beach Park. They always comment about how beautiful it is here, and how much they would like to ‘sleep east and drive west’ for the *Cruisin’ the Coast* festivities. We looked around the country at other sporting and recreational events, and saw the opportunity to create an RV City and have more of them wake up looking out at the Gulf from our beautiful Point Park,” Maxwell said. “Overnight guests at the Point will also get an amazing view of Ingalls Shipbuilding right across the river, which we all know is an inspiring thing to see.”

Cruisin’ the Coast is October 6-13, 2019. RV City at the Point is open to any registered Cruiser with a self-contained RV. Each of the 45 spots is 25’ x 60’, allowing space for the recreational vehicle, their vintage car and a 10’x10’ tent. All trailers will be dropped at a secure location nearby. RV City at Point Park opens on Saturday, October 5th and the \$500 fee enables them to stay thru Sunday, October 13th.

The Committee hopes that Cruisers will take advantage of the Saturday move in day and visit the ZONTA Arts and Crafts festival, taking place Saturday, October 5th in downtown Pascagoula. Point Park will remain open to visitors and fishermen during RV City.

Main Street will be distributing a booklet to RV City guests containing discounts and offers from area merchants, restaurants, and grocery stores. “We want them to come and stay awhile,” Maxwell said. “Our hospitality, the picturesque view along our beachfront and riverfront, and the restaurants and stores...Cruisers and guests are in for a treat again this year.”
