Information About Cruisin' the Coast 'Goula Cruise 2019 at Beach Park A Few Helpful Reminders to Citizens and Visitors

The 'Goula Cruise Committee is proud to welcome all registered Cruisers and visitors to Pascagoula on Thursday, October 10 through Saturday, October 12. We're excited that Pascagoula is an official Cruisin' the Coast sanctioned stamp site again this year. Here are some things to remember during this three-day event:

The following Streets will be CLOSED to the public Thursday-Saturday from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.:

Market Street (from Washington Avenue to Beach Boulevard)

Beach Boulevard (from Buena Vista Street to City Park Street)

The public is invited to Beach Park to stroll through hundreds of classic cars, listen to live music and enjoy local food vendors. Public parking can be found on the map provided. A shuttle will run between the 11th Street parking lot and the park all day. Handicap parking is designated by a police officer at the City Park Street entrance to Beach Park.

Golf carts MUST park in the designated area on Oliver Street. ONLY golf carts driven by Cruisin' the Coast Committee and volunteers are allowed inside Beach Park per Cruisin' the Coast official rules.

There will be a special Movie Night featuring *Cars* on Friday, October 11th at 6:30 p.m. at Beach Park.

Please remember the Beach Park Splash Pad is CLOSED during this event. Beach Park will resume normal hours on Sunday, October 13.
