Pascagoula City Council COVID-19 3rd Amended Resolution 04/21/2020

PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI –

The Pascagoula City Council met on Tuesday, April 21, 2020, at 6:00 pm to discuss potential mitigation in light of COVID-19 for retail businesses deemed “Essential Businesses or Operations” as defined by Executive Order No. 1463. At the meeting, the following regulations were agreed upon:

1. The City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby adopts and implements the following regulations, which shall remain in effect until the City Council’s May 5, 2020 regular meeting wherein said regulations may be amended, rescinded, or superseded by another applicable Resolution of the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi:
2. Retail businesses deemed “Essential Businesses or Operations” as defined by Executive Order No. 1463, including, but not limited to, grocery stores, supermarkets, convenience stores, hardware and building materials stores, automotive sales and repairs stores, pharmacies, feed stores, and office supply stores, shall ensure the following:
 - (a) That for every 1,000 square feet of gross building footage, only one-and-one-half (1.5) customers shall be permitted in any such business’s building (this limitation does not apply to the business’s employees); and

(b) That customers queueing in line or otherwise congregating outside of all such businesses shall remain six (6) feet apart from others.
