

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF AN APPRAISER
FOR BRIARWOOD DRAINAGE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula is engaged in performing drainage repairs and upgrades in the Briarwood neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the drainage project requires acquisition of permanent and temporary easements on a certain parcel of land; and

WHEREAS, the owners of said parcel of land have indicated that they are not willing to donate said easements to the City of Pascagoula; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary and in the City's best interest to obtain appraisals of the value of the easements; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney requests that the City Council authorize the retention of Kim Seaman to prepare appraisals of the two easements; and

WHEREAS, Kim Seaman's fee for the preparation of the desired appraisals is \$1,500.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Pascagoula to retain Kim Seaman for the purposes stated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The matters, facts, and things recited in the Preamble hereto are hereby adopted as the official findings of the City Council of the City of Pascagoula.

SECTION 2: That it would be in the best interest of the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi to retain Kim Seaman to prepare appraisals for temporary and permanent easements on the subject parcel.

SECTION 3: That the City Council authorizes the City Attorney to retain Kim Seaman to prepare such appraisals and further authorizes the City Manager and Comptroller to issue payment in the amount of \$1,500.00 to Kim Seaman upon completion of the requested services.
