

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
APPROVING AND DISCONTINUING THE LOCAL EMERGENCY
PROCLAIMED REGARDING TROPICAL DEPRESSION NINE**

Whereas, on August 27, 2021, the Mayor of Pascagoula, Mississippi, proclaimed the existence of a local emergency regarding Tropical Depression Nine (Tropical Storm Ida), said Proclamation being attached hereto; and

Whereas, pursuant to Mississippi Code Section 33-15-17, the City Council for the City of Pascagoula hereby reviews and approves the Mayor's Proclamation; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the dangers of Tropical Depression Nine (Tropical Storm Ida) supported and necessitated proclaiming a local emergency; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the conditions that necessitated the initial proclamation of a local emergency no longer exist and, therefore, it is necessary and in the City's best interest to discontinue the local emergency.

Now Therefore be it Resolved as follows:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi hereby reviews and approves the Proclamation of Local Emergency by Mayor Jay Willis regarding Tropical Depression Nine (Tropical Storm Ida), attached hereto.

Section 2: That the City Council of Pascagoula, Mississippi finds that the circumstances necessitating said Proclamation no longer exist, and, accordingly, the City Council hereby discontinues the local emergency regarding Tropical Depression Nine (Tropical Storm Ida).
