**A Motion was made by Estabrook and seconded by Walker** to authorize the Chairman, Dr. Paul H. Moore, to execute the MDA Gulf Coast Restoration Fund Program Grant Agreement for PRA and City Centre. **All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Next, PRA discussed the PRA's power to loan funds to a Developer for a project that is located within an "urban renewal area" and is part of an "urban renewal project" within the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi, as defined in MCA Sec. 43-35-3(1972) known as the "Central Business District." All members present felt confident that MCA Section 43-35-15 granted the PRA the power to make the loan without need for revision to the creation resolution or by-laws, but decided to seek an Attorney General's Opinion on the subject.

**A Motion was made by Estabrook and seconded by Sudduth** to authorize the PRA Attorney to seek an Attorney General's opinion on the PRA's power to loan funds to a Developer for a project that is located within an "urban renewal area" and is part of an "urban renewal project" within the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi,

as defined in MCA Sec. 43-35-3(1972) known as the "Central Business District." **All voted in favor. The motion passed.**
