



The resolution is spread upon the minutes as follows:

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI
RENAMING MCC PARK TO LEE TINGLE PARK**

WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula owns MCC Park, located at 5725 Orchard Road;
WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula desires to rename MCC Park to Lee Tingle Park;
WHEREAS, Lee Tingle was born and raised in Pascagoula, Mississippi, and he is the son of Brenda and Leon Tingle;

WHEREAS, Lee is married to Melissa Tingle, and together they have three children, Tayler, Ty, and Trace, and one grandchild, Joseph Porter;

WHEREAS, along with his devotion to his family, Lee is devoted to this community, particularly through youth sports;

WHEREAS, Lee is currently the head baseball coach at Resurrection Catholic School, where he has served as a coach for over a decade;

WHEREAS, Lee has also served as a coach at Pascagoula High School, coaching both baseball and soccer;

WHEREAS, through his business, Physical Therapy Professionals, Lee has assisted numerous young athletes recover from sports-related injuries; and

WHEREAS, to recognize his significant contributions to this community, the City Council for the City of Pascagoula desires to rename MCC Park to Lee Tingle Park.
